Ms. Howard asked about being an employee rather than a contractor. Krissy explained the City would rather have a contractor as that person would be able to spray for the City (public) and also spray on private property (nothing to do with the City). Council offered her \$2000 for the remainder of the season to spray public property. Travis Garner moved, Chelsea Jones 2nd, to accept Tina Howard as the vector control person for Paisley for spraying on public land. The City will purchase the chemical. MCU. We will work together to develop a "No Spray" map.
