City of Paisley Regular Council Meeting Minutes of October 2, 2023

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u> The Regular Council Meeting of the City of Paisley was held on October 2, 2023, at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Keith Harra called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Council members in attendance were Lora Mayea, Toni Bailie, and Travis Garner. Others in attendance were Rick Wann, Jeri Wann, Dustin Withers, Dee Tate and Melissa Walton, recording minutes.
- 2. <u>Consent Agenda</u> Keith Harra moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the September 18, 2023, Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU. Keith Harra moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the September Invoices, MCU.

3. Business

- 3.1 Paisley Fire Department Lora Mayea stated she was looking for clarification for paying the fire fighters through the grant they received. The minutes for the June 5, 2023 Council meeting state there will be not be overtime pay or hazard pay. Dustin Withers replied he should have clarified that there is not overtime pay in the day-to-day workings of the department but that during conflags the members are paid from the time they leave till the time they return plus two hours after return for cleanup. All this money comes from the state. The equipment rental money during a conflag is income for the department. The state also pays back fill positions during conflags.
- 3.2 Back Up System Cost Keith is donating his mayor stipend to cover the cost of paying for a backup communications system for the City. Dustin stated that a program called Connecting Heroes is working with T Mobile to provide free service for First Responders. The phones for the City would carry a onetime cost of \$140, phone service is free thereafter. First responders will have priority access; if the system is overwhelmed and we need to use the phone, someone else will be kicked off the system so that the first responder can utilize the service. If necessary, a call can bring in a trailer with a tower to bring communications back up. The cradle point will provide all speed necessary and should be able to run most of Paisley. The equipment is estimated to be around \$300 to provide this service. They believe the big test of this set up will come during the upcoming eclipse. Emergency management is expecting the population of Lake County to double. Dustin will update Council at the next meeting on how everything went that weekend.
- 3.3 New Pump for Well #1 Melissa stated that Phil Eide came out to install the new pump in Well #1 but could not get the old material out of the well. Phil estimated they put 30,000 pounds of pressure on it and could not get it to budge. They talked about running a camera down the hole to see what the problem was but realized the hole was too small to accommodate the camera. Phil put the old pump back together and replaced it in the well. He suggests drilling a new well at some point. Council asked that we start looking at well drillers. Keith brought up two floating islands in the lagoons. Need to look into that also. Lora asked about dumping at the lagoon. During the sewer backup a

week or so ago, Gary McCleese came into the office and picked up a key for the lagoon. Lora stated Council had voted not to allowing dumping at the lagoon and asked why he was given a key. Melissa stated Mr. McCleese came in and told her Eugene said to come get the key and rather than call and bother Eugene about it as he was working on the sewer system backing up, she took Gary at his word and gave him the key. Lora stated Eugene had not given him permission.
