## City of Paisley Minutes of April 17, 2023 Special Council Meeting

1. <u>Call to Order</u> The Special Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on April 17, 2023, at Paisley Community Center. President Lora Mayea called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. Council members in attendance were Toni Bailie, Travis Garner, and Wes Houston. Others in attendance: Austin Piper, Matt Withers, Jack O'Leary, Rick & Jeri Wann, and Melissa Walton, recording minutes.

#### 2. Business

- 2.1 Rodeo Grounds Matt Withers stated the club finalized their rodeo schedule the night before. They are planning on a number of events plus three days of Mosquito Festival. Trying to find the funds for a new well at the rodeo grounds was discussed. The club has an above ground infrastructure in place but they have to be careful because it will freeze. With help from the Paisley Fire Department they will keep the water full for their stock.
- 2.2 <u>Homelessness</u> Council received a copy of a homelessness packet that Keith obtained. The homelessness issue is wide spread and is causing issues for everyone involved. Toni Bailie moved to have Paige Sully draft a motion specifying no camping on public property or in the public right of way within the City of Paisley, Travis Garner 2<sup>nd</sup>, MCU.
- 2.3 Procurement Policy Melissa shared some input from Keith on the proposed policy. Council had no other input at the time. Melissa will work on a new draft.
- 2.4 <u>Vector Control</u> One bid was received from Cayla and Gary Chamberlain from Christmas Valley. They bid \$700 per visit to Paisley, this includes chemical. Lora stated this will cost the City quite a bit more than what we've paid previously. Council discussed finding someone local as they are not supposed to spray when it's really windy so these people would have to travel 60+ miles one way only to find out its not feasible that day. Lora Mayea moved, Travis Garner 2<sup>nd</sup>, to advertise in the paper and around town for a local sprayer, MCU.
- 3. <u>Public Appearances</u> Wes asked what was going to be done about the pipe collapse on Mill Street. It was suggested to advertise for a walk in job site repair. They will need to replace about 140 feet of pipe. Toni Bailie moved, Lora Mayea 2<sup>nd</sup>, to advertise for an onsite sewer repair, MCU.

Wes also went into the Lake County Chamber of Commerce and talked to them about the dues the City has paid. He feels we are wasting money with our membership there. He also was told they are discontinuing their bus this year. The City does receive the benefit of free copies with the membership, which we've used a few times this last year for the binder books of resolutions for each Councilor and the copies of the Water Master Plan for each Councilor. The City also receives free advertising with their membership.

Lora discussed the band for Mosquito Festival weekend. She has not been able to reach anyone with Mosquito Festival.
