City of Paisley Special Council Meeting Minutes of January 22, 2024

1. <u>Call to Order</u> The Special Council Meeting of the City of Paisley was held on January 22, 2024, at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Keith Harra called the meeting to order at 12:57 pm. Council members in attendance were Lora Mayea, Toni Bailie, Wes Houston and Travis Garner. Others in attendance were Darryl Anderson, Carmen Tague, John Harms, Eugene Beachler and Melissa Walton, recording minutes.

2. Business

2.1 Anderson Engineering: EPA Grant In 2021 Anderson Engineering began working with Merkley's office on funding for replacing the water system. The original estimate for the cost of the project came from the master plan Anderson had amassed back in 2020. The City was awarded \$2.8 million through the Congressional Direct Spending Fund. The funds were placed with the EPA and they required everyone to reapply. For the water system replacement project, Anderson budgeted the construction cost at \$2,563,033 with a contractual cost of \$205,229. The environmental costs have been blanked out as the EPA is doing a NEPA study themselves. The City is still waiting on an actual contract/agreement from the EPA for the \$2.8 million so that work can begin. Darryl stated there is a shortfall of \$122,000 in costs but they also placed a contingency within the budget for \$278,000. There are other grants and loan programs to cover a shortage. The loans would be low interest and/or a split; part of the loan could be forgivable, and part being paid back.

Darryl stated the next step is to contact landowners near the corner of Blue St., Hwy 31, and Lovers Lane to gain permission for a possible well site. The possible well site will need to be tested for arsenic and the well will need to be deep to ensure there is no interference with the river. Anderson Engineering will move forward with contacting landowners to discuss permission.

Keith asked about meters. It was agreed that it would be helpful to have just one type of meter and to automate the system at the plant. Eugene discussed needing to replace the valves at the storage tank. Darryl said they would get some information together.
