The Fire Department is always on call and ready to defend your property against tragic events such as fire. The Department has, in the past, always depended upon the generous donations from outlying areas to cover the cost of these runs. However, due to decreased voluntary donations, and the economic times that the Department is facing, they are compelled to set a list of fees for services that they provide. These are generally accepted rates and will help the Department offset the ever increasing fees that they face for providing services.
